
Overview - HP ZR22w 21.5-inch S-IPS LCD Monitor



- 1. Menu: Opens, selects or exits the OSD menu.
- 2. Minus (-): Navigates backward through the OSD menu and 5. decreases adjustment levels.
- Plus (+)/Source: Navigates forward through the OSD menu 6. and increases adjustment levels; when the OSD menu is inactive, selects the video input (VGA or DVI or DisplayPort)
- **4.** OK/Auto: When the OSD menu is inactive, activates the auto adjustment feature to optimize the screen image.
- 5. Power: Turns the monitor on or off.
- 6. Power LED:
  Blue = Fully powered.
  Amber = Sleep mode.
  Flashing Amber = Sleep Timer mode








#### Introduction

The HP Quick Release, which ships standard with the HP ZR22w 21.5-inch Widescreen LCD Monitor, is an easy to use, 100 mm VESA-compliant, flat panel monitor mounting solution that allows you to quickly and securely attach a flat panel monitor to a variety of stands, brackets, arms or wall mounts. HP Quick Release can also be used for mounting any combination of devices that are compatible with the 100 mm VESA Flat Display Mounting Interface Standard. The failsafe "Sure-Lock" mechanism snaps the monitor (or mounted device) securely in place, and can be further secured with a theft-deterrent security screw.
